# Want a Street Tree?



- Yard trees are planted on *private property* in front, side, or back yards.
- Yard trees are planted by residents / property owners.
- Yard trees are owned by the property owner and their care is the responsibility of the owner.

- Street trees are planted in holes cut into the sidewalk or in planting strips along the street side of the sidewalk and are planted in the *public right of way*.
- Street trees are planted by volunteer tree tenders groups, city contractors, or qualified contractors hired by owners.
- Street trees care is in all of our hands.
